Mickey Edwards is a former member of Congress from Oklahoma and currently Vice President of the Aspen Institute and Director of the Aspen Institute's Rodel Fellowships in Public Leadership. After serving in Congress, Mr. Edwards taught at Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government where he was the John Quincy Adams Lecturer in Legislative Practice and at Princeton's Woodrow Wilson School of Public and International Affairs. Mr. Edwards is the author or co-author of four books. including "Reclaiming Conservatism," published in 2008 by Oxford University Press. His latest book, "The Parties Versus the People," was published by Yale University Press. He has been a regular political commentator on National Public Radio's "All Things Considered" and a weekly political columnist for The Chicago Tribune and Los Angeles Times, as well as other major newspapers.
